

1283 persons* reporting pushbacks from Croatia to BiH in **September 2021**



out of which **172 persons*** reporting chain pushback incidents

Breakdown per Country of Origin

Pakistan - 603 persons
Afghanistan - 405 persons
Bangladesh - 176 persons
India - 27 persons
Iran - 21 persons
Iraq - 20 persons
Nepal - 11 persons
Gambia - 8 persons
Turkey - 6 persons

In September 2021:

138 children reporting pushbacks to BiH (11%). During September, the incidence rate of reported excessive use of force has drastically increased.

Assistance provided:

A total of **863** direct assistances were provided to persons reporting pushback indicents, mainly in terms of food (FI) and non-food (NFI) item delivery, first-aid medical assistance and first-aid psychosocial assistance.

Additionally, a total of **187** referrals were conducted by DRC staff to relevant service, including but not limited to reception facilities, registration in the country, medical assistance, or direct assistance in terms of FI & NFI distribution.


